Item 3:	<p>CSI Change of competition date to November 29th.</p> <p>Competition dates 2015 from Southland, OAWLA and Netfit.</p>

Matters	
Decision or Recommendations	<p>The CSI change of competition date to November 29th.</p> <p>The 2015 dates for competitions submitted by OAWLA, Southland and Netfit were all accepted and will be added to the 2015 OWNZ Calendar.</p> <p>After discussion regarding the bid by Uncut Weightlifting Club, Dunedin which had been accepted at the AGM subject to an acceptable competition plan it was agreed that the bid from OAWLA could not be accepted. Decision passed unanimously.</p>
Item 4:	HPSNZ funding application update.
Matters	J Moss up dated the current HPSNZ funding which targeted sports capable of attaining top 6 at the Olympics. He had requested talks with HPSNZ in the near future.

Item 5:	Sponsorship John Moss
Matters	The continued need to seek sponsorship was an important ongoing process and R Patterson mentioned the need to use social media to gain wider coverage.
Decision or Recommendations	Sponsorship was an essential element to assist with the delivery of the Strategic Plan and will be discussed at the December EG meeting.
Item 5a:	OTIP nominees – Kanah Andrews-Nahu and Kieren Hempsey. Update on Pacific Cup representatives. Garry Marshall
	Both nominees had been accepted by OWF and air tickets had been received. Parents or Grandparents would be accompanying kanah.
	There was discussion regarding the selection of athletes for the 2015 OTIP program. The EO explained the nature of the program being such that qualification totals were not the best way to establish potential and commitment which were the essential elements of OTIP selection. It was agreed to look at this in the new year when the 2015 OTIP program was confirmed.
Item 6:	International Calendar Qualifying periods and standards John Moss
Matters	
Decision and Recommendations	After brief discussion it was agreed that the selectors would provide the 2015 qualifying standards and periods. As a temporary measure the 2015 OWNZ Calendar would provide guideline figures which will assist coaches and lifters with forward planning. It was also agreed that events which would not have OWNZ financial

Item 7:	Youth Commonwealth Games Samoa 5 – 11 September.
Matters:	J Moss explained that the organizing committee had allocated 3 non gender specific places for NZ athletes. At this stage weight and age groups have not been announced. Qualifying periods and further information will be provided when OWNZ receives them from the organizing committee.
Item 8:	Website: Upgrade and online registration for the 2015 season Richie Patterson
Matters	Discussion on the possible merits of using the AWF website information as opposed to local website developers.
Decision or Recommendations	It was agreed that R Patterson be given permission to liaise with providers willing to have a program in place by January 2015. Moved by GM/RP that \$2000 from current funds be allocated to this project. Passed unanimously.
Item 9:	Lottery Grants: OWNZ online registration for Grant Applications Richie Patterson.

Decision or Recommendations	After brief discussion it was agreed that R Patterson would look at online registration and carry out any necessary processes.
Item 10:	Strategic Planning documentation Richie Patterson.

Decision or Recommendations	Agreed that OWNZ continue to support the good work being done by this small committee.

Matters	This By Law has been circulated to Auckland Clubs and other clubs will be contacted when clinics/seminar dates have been established in areas other than Auckland.
Decision or Recommendations	It was agreed that the new By Laws presented by R Patterson be added to the OWNZ By Laws and placed on the website. The vote was not unanimous with one vote against.
